

Call for Papers

We invite education researchers, in-service and pre-service teachers, and members of other educational institutions to submit their research as well as best-practice teaching examples focusing to impart **knowledge on LGBT+**, and to **reduce prejudices and discrimination against LGBT+**.

We welcome contributions for **presentations, posters, and workshops**.

The submission is possible only online via [Home – All Inc! Conference München 2023 \(converia.de\)](https://converia.de) from **December 1, 2022** up to **March 31, 2023**.

Presentation:

Presentations should include research and provide the objective(s), research questions, methodology, and a summary of the key findings and conclusions (duration 20 minutes + 10 minutes Q&A).

Poster:

Posters should provide the objective, the research questions and the (planned) research design. They will be presented during the conference in a poster hallway, whereby the authors give an overview over their project and answer questions. Pre-service teachers are invited explicitly to present their bachelor/master theses. Posters have to be printed on DIN A0, and brought along to the conference by the presenters themselves.

Workshop:

Workshops should provide teaching methods and materials. They should include an overview over the learning objectives and the age group, followed by a “hands on” phase, whereby the authors enable participants to use and experience the methods and materials (duration 60 minutes + 30 minutes discussion).
